My concern: Strange and/or Suspicious individuals wandering around the association's retention pond shoreline under the guise of fishing.

It is my belief that one or more of these individuals is/has been "casing" our community for the purposes of future Break & Enter activities, patio equipment theft, window peeping, or other activities that would be hazardous to our residents.

I have recently confronted several individuals, along with capturing them on digital photography media, and have been told boldly that since they are residents of any of the communities making up the East Village association they are permitted to fish along the entire shoreline of any and all of the retention ponds.

When I have specifically asked for the individual residential address(s) of these characters, I've been told "I live over there", but no specific address is ever given.

For this board to work aggressively with the other community boards and ban the communal fishing freedom that is currently perceived. Permit only residents and guests of each individual community to fish their own association shoreline.


Solution 2:
