

# Acceptable Use Policy

---

**East Village Master Association** hereafter referred to as **EVMA** grants you access to their Wi-Fi Network providing you agree to abide by this policy.

## **Introduction**

This policy outlines the standards which EVMA requires all users of its electronic communications systems and equipment to follow.

## **What is covered by the Policy?**

The use of the Wi-Fi Network supplied by EVMA.

## **Who is covered by the Policy?**

This policy covers all individuals who wish to use the Wi-Fi Network supplied by EVMA.

## **Internet Use**

Users are reminded that their use of the Internet will be directly traceable to our internet address. We therefore ask you not to visit sites which are:

- 1) defamatory, threatening, intimidating or which could be classed as harassment
- 2) contain obscene, profane or abusive language
- 3) contain pornographic material whether in writing, pictures, films or video clips
- 4) contain offensive material regarding sex, race, religion or any disability or sexual orientation
- 5) infringe third party rights or is otherwise unlawful or inappropriate
- 6) or any illegal site under current law

## **Systems and Data Security**

EVMA will provide internet access via a wireless network and will undertake all reasonable steps to ensure it is secure from unauthorized users. However no guarantee can be made to this effect. You are responsible for your own anti-virus and anti-malware precautions.

When accessing the Wi-Fi network you are required to use the credentials provided. These login details are for the use of East Village residents and their guests. The Password should be kept confidential and not made available to anyone unless they are authorized to have them by the EVMA.

You should not attempt to gain access to restricted areas of the network or to any password protected information without being duly authorized to do so.

## **Monitoring and Compliance**

EVMA reserves the right to protect its network and systems by recording user ACTIVITY but not CONTENT. That is to say no CONTENT will be captured but that a list of surfing activity maybe recorded;

- 1) to insure that the use of the system is legitimate and in accordance with this policy
- 2) to comply with any legal obligation

If the use constitutes a criminal offence the information will be handed to the police.
